


Onsen (the name given to natural thermal baths in Japan) is a wonderful picture book inspired by a true story in a real region. It is about a group of monkeys that live in a Japanese valley with freezing, snowy winters and enjoy bathing in volcanic baths. With skilful narration through illustration, Pato Mena shows us what these monkeys get up to, including their routines and amusing games. Children will definitely relate to them.

Pato Mena (Buin, Chile, 1980) is a writer and illustrator of children's literature and comics. His books have been published in Spain, Chile, the USA, France, Italy, Argentina, Korea, China, Japan and Macedonia. His work has been recognised with several prizes, like the award for Best Picture Book at the 2017 International Latino Awards in Los Angeles. In 2016, he was honoured by the Junior Library Guild Selection, linked to public libraries in the USA, for *The Perfect Siesta* (Nubeocho). He currently lives and works in Barcelona.



The Adventures of Stacey and Pepper is a series of short comics for early readers. Each book contains two adventures starring two rather unique characters: a little girl and a talking pony, accompanied by just one adult. The adventures revolve around common themes in children's books, including bath time, baby teeth and head lice, all dealt in a simple, fresh way, with minimalistic yet highly evocative illustrations and text. Feliu was inspired to create Stacey and Pepper by conversations with his daughter.

Juan Feliu (Mallorca, 1971) is a truly multifaceted artist. Having completed degrees in Building Engineering, Geography and History and Technical Architecture, he now works as a technical architect at Palma City Council. He is also the founder of Mallorcan band Vacabou (2002–2014), in which he was an instrumentalist and wrote songs. In terms of collaborations, he has worked with artists like writer Agustín Fernández Mallo, with whom he created the group Frida Laponia in 2012, and Bernardí Roig. The Adventures of Stacey and Pepper is his first foray into the world of comics.

Stacey and Pepper are the loveable main characters of a series of comics that are sure to make early readers laugh and smile.

Despite being a newcomer to the world of children's literature, Anna Font won her second picture book award with this title. *Gafarró's New Hat* tells the story of a man who feels uncomfortable in social situations. One day, though, the wind plays a trick on him, taking his hat away and forcing him to mix with people on the street. Anna Font manages to mix text and illustration as skilfully as she blends the main character with the people around him.

Anna Font (Barcelona, 1969) is an artist specialising in illustration for children's and young people's books and posters. She has illustrated several picture books, some of which have won prizes; a notable example is Plous o fas sol? [Are You Raining or Sunny?] by Mireia Vidal, published by Akiara Books, which won the 2020 Serra d'Or Critics' Award. The illustrator has also worked on children's magazines El Tatano (Cavall Fort) and Pantera (Savanna Books) and was selected as a finalist at the 2021 Bologna Children's Book Fair.

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This is a picture book inspired by the news story that the Danish government rescued various circus animals to give them a better life. With *Ali and Ramboline*, Valentí Gubianas immortalises and recreates the friendship between an elephant and a dromedary, which get separated. A group of kids see how sad they are and how much they miss each other, so they embark on a mission to reunite the pair. Gubianas combines colours and space to put across the powerful emotions the story stirs up to areat effect.

Valentí Gubianas (Navàs, 1969). Having worked in a host of different fields, he discovered illustration during his studies at Escola Massana in Barcelona. He then started illustrating children's books, picture books, textbooks and websites. With a growing need for more space to draw, he decided to work on murals in schools, in libraries and on façades, as well as on live shows. He combines his book illustrating and mural painting activities with visiting schools, where he learns a lot from his direct contact with readers.

Mr Shaun's Tree is all about the day-to-day relationship between an old man who lives on his own and the tree in his garden. A minimalistic story in terms of both action, which focuses on how Mr Shaun observes and takes care of the tree, and the essential elements that make up Neus Caamaño's illustrations. The empty, clean pages emphasise the varied colours of the tree's leaves, at the heart of the story, alongside Mr Shaun's gentle, friendly movements.



The exciting twists and turns and surprises on every page captivate the reader, maintaining the tension and intrigue until the last sentence.

Meritxell Martí (Sabadell, 1972) holds degrees in both Humanities and Classical and Modern Music. For 10 years, she taught Art, Film and Literature at the Open University of Catalonia. She completed a doctorate with a thesis on art on the internet (awarded cum laude honours) and is now studying for the Remind master's degree at the University of Barcelona. Around thirty children's and young people's books have been published by her, some of which have been translated into French, Italian, Portuguese, Korean, Turkish, Bulgarian and Greek.

Xavier Salomó (Sabadell, 1976) graduated in Drawing and Illustration from the Escola Massana in Barcelona, where he was granted the Extraordinary End-of-Degree Award in the printing category. The Professional Association of Illustrators of Catalonia has awarded him the Junceda Prize twice, and he has received a number of accolades in France. The picture book *OFF* marked a change in direction in his production.

Sunakay is another delight straight out of the Martí-Salomó factory, all about the deterioration of our environment and the future of our planet.

She is the main character of a series in which Jordi Fenosa and Jordi Sunyer join forces to bring their stories to young readers, combining the languages of novels and of comics, with a relaxed tone, a dynamic style and plenty of humour. Each instalment is a different adventure based on an environmental theme (unnecessary construction, overuse of plastic, etc.).

Jordi Fenosa (Barcelona, 1965). Having studied at the School of Arts and Crafts and the Escola Joso, the comic and visual arts centre, he began to publish comics with Italian and German publishers in 1988. In 1990, he started to illustrate for publishing houses specialising in children's books; since then, he has illustrated more than fifty books and novels for the leading publishers of children's literature.

Jordi Sunyer (Barcelona, 1976). His career as an illustrator began in 1997. Some of his books have been published all over the world.

Alongside his illustration work, he has developed graphic design projects and taken part in exhibitions as a painter in Spain, France, Germany, Italy and the United Arab Emirates. He was chosen to feature in the 'Books in Catalan' exhibition during the 2017 Bologna Children's Book Fair.


Maria Espluga (Barcelona, 1968) studied

It is narrated through various voices, with a gentle rhythm, a delicate development and illustrations by the author.

Bernat Cormand (Barcelona, 1973–2021) was a philologist, illustrator and writer. His picture books include El dibuixant d'óssos [The Bear Sketcher], El nen perfecte [The Perfect Boy] and Els dies feliços [Happy Days], and he illustrated Mercè Rodoreda's Viatges i flors [Journeys and Flowers], among other books. He was the editor of the Faristol children's and young people's literature magazine, a literary critic for the Ara newspaper, and a lecturer on the Translation and Interpreting degree course at Pompeu Fabra University. All of his work—whether literary,

journalistic or educational-focused on improving LGBTQ+

visibility in children's and young people's literature.
