He is currently president of the Associació d'Amics de Miquel Martí i Pol.

Natasha Domanova is a story illustrator. She stepped into the limelight after winning the Vila de Térmens Picture Prize award. She grew up in Minsk in a family of artists - her grandparents were artists and her mother a recognized painter based in Japan - and she studied at the leading art school in Belarus.



Joan Turu (1984) is one of the most active and widely recognized Catalan illustrators at the moment. In his latest works he has moved on from doing illustrations of texts by various other writers, to creating all his own texts.

Etiquetes is a picture book which in a precise and clear manner deals with the labels that society, friends and family attach to a person. The book follows a little girl since her birth to point out how those labels restrict, condition, and weigh on her.

Joan Turu was born in 1984 and he studied illustration at the Manresa School of Art. Since then has remained closely linked to both the graphic arts world and the educational field and has played an active role in various related associations.





A very original story that combines elements of traditional fantasy with a contemporary and global touch.

A hallucinatory folksy modern tale with traditional elements and surprising new angles. An egg, found in the forest where the seven witches play out their usual adventures, and the unicorn that emerges from the egg, stir all of that up, rendering a mesmerizing contemporary tall tale. Behind this story is a powerful writer, Bel Olid, with a lauded career, and Pep Montserrat, one of the most renowned illustrators in Catalonia. The combination works perfectly.

Bel Olid. Winner of the Roc Boronat Short Story Prize, Documenta Novel Prize and QWERTY award, she is one of the most important voices of the Catalan generation of the seventies. She is a writer, translator, and teacher of translation at the Universitat Autònoma de Barcelona, and a regular contributor to various cultural media outlets. In addition, she is the former president of the CEATL and, since 2015, president of the Associació d'Escriptors en Llengua Catalana.

Pep Montserrat is an artist based in Barcelona having focused primarily on children's books and editorial illustration since 1988, but also teaching illustration at La Massana Arts & Design School since 1998. His books have been mostly published in Spain and the United States, but also in France, Italy, Greece, Switzerland, Brazil and Korea. His work has been featured in newspapers and magazines in Spain, France, the United States and Abu Dhabi.

In this book she poetically describes the boys and girls who live on different floors of the same apartment building and the experiences they share in the various common spaces such as the landings and the upper terrace.

The poems have the flavour of folk tales and the sound of certain singsong verses all stitched together with the use of onomatopoeia, word plays, songs and rhymes, among other elements.



This original and thought-provoking book leads us to discover two rising artists and see the world from a different perspective.

Alba Dalmau, an established novelist, and artist Cinta Vidal, internationally recognized for her pictorial work and murals, join forces in this picture book targeted to a broad audience that is a reflection on the conventional way we look at things and an invitation to change our point of view. The world is literally upside down and the main character's cat is missing. In her search for it the brief text serves as a path through which to discover and admire the surprising details of the illustrations in which Cinta Vidal decontextualizes buildings, furniture and people and has them floating in the air, playing on perspective, geometry, and weightlessness, with drawings that call to mind M.C. Escher's impossible figures.

Alba Dalmau (Cardedeu, 1987) she holds an undergraduate degree in Audiovisual Communication and a Master's Degree in literary creation from Universitat Pompeu Fabra. In 2011 she published her first novel, Vonlenska, which was awarded the Premi Recvll. She lived in New York where she wrote the novel Bategant (Cossetània, 2015) awarded the 2015 Vila de l'Ametlla de Mar Prize, and the short story collection Estàndards (Angle, 2017) winner of the 28th Vila d'Ascó Literary Prize. In 2019 she published El camí dels esbarzers (Angle) and in 2020 entered into the world of children's literature with Capgirat. She currently teaches creative writing at the Barcelona Laboratori de Lletres.

Cinta Vidal has been drawing and painting non-stop from a very early age. She studied Illustration at the Escola Massana in Barcelona. At the age of 16 she worked as a part-time apprentice at the Castells Planas de St. Agnes de Malanyanes Stage Design workshop where, over the years, Josep and Jordi Castells taught her the craft of painting backdrops and the importance of stage design. Illustration is something she has never ceased to explore. She has worked freelance for various clients and has steadily moved in the direction of painting and producing her own works.

A brief and quaint story about Salvador Dalí's childhood teddy bear, which also won over the heart of poet Federico García Lorca. Don Osito Marquina is the name of a little teddy bear that Salvador Dalí's parents brought home from Paris for their two little boys. Now it is the title of a picture book that is a brief diary beautifully illustrated by Zuzanna Celej, telling the story about the little stuffed bear. The Dalí brothers welcomed the bear as one more member of the family. When the poet García Lorca visited the family, he realized just how much he meant to them and chose to name him Mr. Marquina the Bear and later on would send him letters and post cards. In 1987 Dalí donated the teddy bear to the Museu del Joguet in Figueres where, still today, it occupies a special place in that toy museum.


Joan Manuel Soldevila was born in
Barcelona in 1964 and lives in Figueres.
He is a secondary school teacher of Spanish literature and language in that city, and a specialist in comics and mass communication.
He combines his teaching work with writing and exhibition curation and is a regular contributor to various print media outlets. But one outstanding facet of his professional life is that of being a Tintín expert, leading him to write the Tintín and Hergé Universe, among other works based on the famous Belgian comic character.

Zuzanna Celej was born in 1982 and currently lives in Girona. She received her degree in Fine Arts from the University of Barcelona and then specialized in illustration at the Llotja School of Art and Design in Barcelona. Her career has focused on editorial illustration and the publication of over twenty albums. She has achieved broad international outreach with her illustrations exhibited in Poland, the United States, France and England, and has received numerous national and International prizes for her work, the most recent being the 2020 Golden Pinwheel Young Illustrators Competition.

She does so with clear illustration, a good touch of humor, and a very precise text.

A father and son visit a museum. As the father stands spellbound observing a work of art, a character in another painting invites the son to visit the museum. Moving from hall to hall the young boy learns about 20th-century art movements, each of them depicted on fold-out pages with few words and some examples.

In order to move from one to the next, the reader must follow a labyrinth based on a work from each art movement.

Luisa Vera was born in Elda, Alicante. In 1985, she completed her Fine Arts studies in Valencia and went to New York where she attended the School of Visual Arts. Since 1990, she has focused her work on illustration. Her pieces have been featured in the New York Times, Chicago Tribune, Dallas Morning News, Wall Street Journal, International Herald Tribune, La Vanguardia and El País, and her characters have sported their finest clothes on book covers, posters, catalogs, children's stories and at exhibitions. She has been living in Barcelona since 2002.

Grants

LITERATURE TRANSLATION

Grants for the translation of Catalan literature: fiction, poetry, plays, graphic novels and scholarly works (non-fiction and the humanities)

Recipients: Publishers.

LITERATURE PROMOTION

Grants for activities aimed at promoting Catalan and Aranese literature abroad, including participation in international literary events and promotional plans focused on illustrated works.

Recipients: Publishers, Literary Events Organizers.

ILLUSTRATED BOOKS

Grants for the publication abroad of illustrated books by illustrators settled in Catalonia or the Balearic Islands.

Recipients: Publishers.

PROMOTIONAL MATERIALS

Grants for the creation of materials used in the promotion abroad of Catalan works.

Recipients: Catalan Publishers, Literary Agencies.

TRANSLATORS IN RESIDENCY

Grants for translators working on translations from Catalan to stay from two to six weeks in Catalonia.

Recipients: Translators.

TRAVEL FOR AUTHORS

Grants for writers and illustrators to finance travel costs in order to carry out literary activities, to which they have been invited.

Recipients: Writers in Catalan and illustrators with at least two books originally published in Catalan.



Llull Fellowship

In 2021 the Institut Ramon Llull is organising the 20th edition of its fellowship aimed at international publishers and agents. This will take place in Barcelona in September, during the 39th Setmana del Llibre en Català (Catalan Book Week Festival).

HISTORY

First launched in 2007, when Catalan Culture was Guest of Honour at the Frankfurt Book Fair, the project was designed to foster the translation of Catalan works into other languages and their introduction into new markets. Since then, over 173 professionals from 32 countries have participated in this fellowship.

GOAL

The programme aims to provide the participants with a more in-depth perspective on Catalan literature and the Catalan publishing sector as well as to build networks among Catalan and international publishing houses and literary agencies.
