

Since then he has remained closely linked to the graphic arts world and the educational field and has played an active role in various related associations. Among his other works are




Bel Olid (Mataró, 1977) is a writer, translator, professor of translation at the Universitat Autònoma de Barcelona and a contributor to many cultural programs and media outlets. She became known when she won the 2010 Documenta Prize for the novel Una terra solitària, and the Rovelló Essay Prize for Les heroïnes contrataquen that same year. She has served as president of the Conseil Européen des Associations de Traducteurs Littéraires and was president of the Associació d'Escriptors en Llengua Catalana.

Pep Montserrat (Monistrol de Montserrat, 1966) studied at the Vic School of Art and Design and the Llotja School of Art and Design in Barcelona. He combines his illustration work with graphic design, teaching, and collaborating in print media. His illustrations in children's and YA books have been published around the world and have received several awards, including the National Illustration Prize, the International Catalonia Prize and the Junceda Prize.

Together, they will escape from a thousand piranhas, they will cross the sea in a pirate ship and they will have a ton of adventures, creating memories that will last for generations.

Rocio Bonilla (Barcelona, 1970) earned her degree in Fine Arts. Her first solo picture book was Cara de pardal, published by Bromera. De quin color és un petó is her big international success, translated into more than 20 languages and with more than 300,000 readers around the world. Her other titles with Bromera include La muntanya de llibres més alta del món, Els fantasmes no toquen a la porta, co-written with Eulàlia Canal, Max i els superherois, co-written with Oriol Malet, and Germans.

Feliu was inspired to create Stacey and Pepper by conversations with his daughter.



In terms of collaborations, he has worked with artists like writer Agustín Fernández Mallo, with whom he created the group Frida Laponia in 2012, and Bernardí Roig. A minimalistic story in terms of both action, which focuses on how Mr Shaun observes and takes care of the tree, and the essential elements that make up Neus Caamaño's illustrations. The empty, clean pages emphasise the varied colours of the tree's leaves, at the heart of the story, alongside Mr Shaun's gentle, friendly movements.

Neus Caamaño (Terradelles, 1984) is an illustrator and currently lives in Seville. After studying Fine Arts, she discovered the world of illustration, and now works for publishing houses like Akiara and Tres Tigres Tristes.



Mireia Vidal (Barcelona, 1972) has worked as a script writer on films (Les mans buides [Empty-Handed], selected at Cannes in 2003) and on children's animations and series. She now teaches script writing (Barcelona Film School, Cinema and Audiovisual School of Catalonia) and writes short stories, comics and a blog (Diari d'una dona en pràctiques [Diary of an Apprentice Woman]).

Total Adventure is a comic series for ages 7 and up. It is also the name of an unpopular class at school run by a strange teacher. Our two heroes sign up, and soon discover the teacher's secret: a spacecraft that will take them on many adventures. With a comic-book narration full of adventure and humour, Total Adventure blasts onto the children's scene.

Jaume Copons (Barcelona, 1966) is a scriptwriter for the Spanish version of Sesame Street (TVE), the creator of TV programs such as Los Lunnis (TVE), Los Algos (Cuatro), Mirasatele (IB3) and of songs, opening credits, and advertisements for television. He has written more than 40 novels for young readers, including La Mà Negra and the series Jo, Elvis Riboldi and Agus i els monstres, which has been published in many languages. In addition to Bono Bidari, he also uses the pseudonyms Julián Aguilar and Lilian Wallaby.

Òscar Julve (Barcelona, 1972) studied Fine Arts at the University of Barcelona and has worked as an illustrator, cartoonist and caricaturist on a wide range of publishing, advertising and audiovisual projects. He joined forces with Ramon Cabrera, Daniel Cerdà and Jaume Copons to publish books including La Companyia del Balta [Balta's Company] and Jo, Elvis Riboldi [I, Elvis Riboldi] under the pseudonym Bono Bidari, and won the Atrapallibres Prize for this last title in 2013.





The exciting twists and turns and surprises on every page captivate the reader, maintaining the tension and intrigue until the last sentence.

Meritxell Martí (Sabadell, 1972) holds degrees in both Humanities and Classical and Modern Music. For 10 years, she taught Art, Film and Literature at the Open University of Catalonia. She completed a doctorate with a thesis on art on the internet (awarded cum laude honours) and is now studying for the Remind master's degree at the University of Barcelona. Around thirty children's and young people's books have been published by her, some of which have been translated into French, Italian, Portuguese, Korean, Turkish, Bulgarian and Greek.



Imapla's books for the youngest children stand out for their stunning high-impact design. *Hidden Numbers* teaches kids the numbers while stimulating their imagination: visualizing the numbers and identifying them by logical association with animal figures. The author presents the numbers one through twenty in clear, high-contrast drawings: I is a horse; 2 is a duck; 3 is a swallow... along with a phrase that links the image with the number.

Imapla (Barcelona, 1964) studied Graphic Design at the Elisava art school in Barcelona. She began her career contributing to various magazines, newspapers and in advertising, for several outlets and in several disciplines. She won the 1992 Apel·les Mestres Award, which inspired her to devote more time to illustration. Some years ago she embarked on her own adventure as an author (adopting the name Imapla) of both text and image. In 2007, she was awarded the International Illustration Prize by the Fundación SM. She currently works in both illustration and graphic design.

Each instalment is a different adventure based on an environmental theme (unnecessary construction, overuse of plastic, etc.).

Jordi Fenosa (Barcelona, 1965). Having studied at the School of Arts and Crafts and the Escola Joso, the comic and visual arts centre, he began to publish comics with Italian and German publishers in 1988. In 1990, he started to illustrate for publishing houses specialising in children's books; since then, he has illustrated more than fifty books and novels for the leading publishers of children's literature.

Jordi Sunyer (Barcelona, 1976). His career as an illustrator began in 1997. Some of his books have been published all over the world. Alongside his illustration work, he has developed graphic design projects and taken part in exhibitions as a painter in Spain, France, Germany, Italy and the United Arab Emirates. He was chosen to feature in the 'Books in Catalan' exhibition during the 2017 Bologna Children's Book Fair.



With this novel for all sort of readers, Josep L. Badal shows off his rich, disconcerting imagination, enhanced by Zuzanna Celej's gorgeous illustrations and the beautifully presented edition. A story about a boy who runs away from home, looking for a place where no one will pressure or overwhelm him. His voyage takes him on absurd missions in imaginary worlds, with many kinds of creatures questioning him. The book has no specific message but it explores the human condition.

Josep L. Badal (Ripollet del Vallès, 1966) is a Catalan Philology graduate and teaches Language and Literature. He has published reviews and creative writing in specialist magazines, along with several fiction books and various poetry collections. His children's literature output includes the wonderful Els llibres d'A [A's Books and the Jan Plata series.

Zuzanna Celej (Poland, 1982) now lives in Girona, having graduated in Fine Arts from the University of Barcelona and trained in Illustration at the Llotja School of Art and Design. She has published more than twenty picture books and her work has reached readers worldwide: her illustrations have been seen in Poland, the USA and France. Her accolades include various national and international prizes, and she was a finalist at the 2020 Golden Pinwheel Young Illustrators Competition.

The author invites readers in with her ironic tone so they can learn from primates, in order to "become more human, more just, and more humble.

Maite Carranza (Barcelona, 1958) is a writer with over 30 years of professional experience and more than 50 published titles. Translated into more than 40 languages, she is among the Catalan authors with the greatest international presence. Her transgressive and committed books for children and teens have earned her numerous awards, including three Serra d'Or Critics' Prizes (in 1986, 2010, and 2018), the 2011 Spanish National Award, the Edebé Prize in both 2002 and 2010, the 2014 Cervantes Chico Award, and most recently the 2018 Atrapallibres and the 2018 Joaquim Ruyra Prize.

Safari is a comic novel that pays homage to the mythical adventures of Tarzan and fosters a respect for nature and other animal species.

Featuring a wide cast of characters fighting to find their place in the world, often in the midst of great difficulty, the novels create a realism that provokes debate and reflection. 


