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Session Descriptions

- <u>Group Working Sessions 1-5 Workshops & Discussions:</u> These performative workshop sessions will explore Research-based Theatre through *doing*; we will collectively engage in drama exercises to better understand the methodology's potential and parameters. The discussion portion of these sessions will allow the group to consider Research-based Theatre's adaptability to each residency member's unique research, education, and community contexts.
 - Group Working Session 1: What is RbT?
 In our initial session, we will develop a shared understanding and working definition of Research-based Theatre through drama-based strategies and discussion.
 - Our second group session 2: Excerpts & Sharing
 Our second group session allows members to share excerpts from their work for discussion. All group members are invited to share a 5-minute summary of a current project, excerpt from a recently completed or work-in-progress script, theatre piece, other creative work, or academic manuscript. Please choose a selection that connects to research as theatre practices, collaboration with diverse communities, or highlights a particular group you currently work with. This is an informal sharing session, so please do not feel the need to prepare a power-point or rehearse a presentation.
 - Group Working Session 3: RbT in Context
 A discussion session that focuses on collectively conceiving an RbT framework that may be flexible enough for implementation across the various communities we work with.
 - Group Working Session 4: Multiplicity of Approaches
 We will play with the diverse methodological expertise in the group and draw on our various approaches to facilitate a workshop where we explore narrative sharing related to personal identity and autobiography.
 - Group Working Session 5: Consolidation & Looking Forward

 This session will offer space to review and consolidate our collective explorations and look forward to planning residency outcomes.

 - o Group members are invited to select their focus for these sessions. This is an opportunity to join a group nature walk or work on your own project.
- Individual Work:
 - o Group members are invited to select an individual project to focus on. Conversations throughout the residency will allow us to connect over individual projects.
