

Resolution opening the 2nd call 2025 for the granting of subsidies under a competitive competition regime for the editorial production of translations of original literary works in Catalan and Occitan (in their Aranese variety)

The purpose of the Institut Ramon Llull Consortium (hereinafter, the Institut Ramon Llull) is to project and disseminate the Catalan language and culture abroad in all its expressions. In order to achieve its objectives, the Institut Ramon Llull will support the external relations policies in the cultural field of the consortium institutions.

By Agreement of the Board of Directors of the Institut Ramon Llull dated 16 January 2025, the modification of the terms and conditions governing the granting of subsidies for the editorial production of translations of original literary works in Catalan and Occitan (in their Aranese variety) is approved.

By resolution dated 22 January 2025 (DOGC no. 9337, of 27 January 2025), the Agreement of the Board of Directors dated 16 January 2025 is published, modifying the terms and conditions governing the granting of subsidies for the editorial production of translations of original literary works in Catalan and Occitan (in their Aranese variety).

In accordance with Articles 87 et seq. of the Revised Text of the Law on Public Finances of Catalonia, approved by Legislative Decree 3/2002, of 24 December, and the basic precepts of Law 38/2003, of 17 November, on General Subsidies and Royal Decree 887/2006, of 21 July, approving the Regulations of the aforementioned Law;

Making use of the powers attributed to me by article 13.2 e) of the Statutes of the Institut Ramon Llull,

## I resolve:

1. To open the 2nd call 2025 for the awarding of subsidies on a competitive basis for the editorial production of translations of original literary works in Catalan and Occitan (in their Aranese variety) to be carried out from the date of publication of the resolution awarding the subsidies until 15 November 2026.

The subsidies provided for in this call are governed by the modification of the bases approved by Agreement of the Board of Directors dated 16 January 2025 published in the DOGC no. 9337, of 27 January 2025 and by the general regulations on subsidies.

2. Establish that the maximum endowment of the call is 10,000.00 euros. This amount is distributed in the following annuities:

A maximum amount of 2,000.00 euros charged to the budget of the Institut Ramon Llull for the year 2025 with the following budget items, which have adequate and sufficient credit:

A maximum amount of 8,000.00 euros charged to the budget of the Institut Ramon Llull for the year 2026 with the following budget items, subject to the existence of adequate and sufficient credit:

The maximum allocation may be increased depending on the applications received, for an amount not exceeding that of the call, and subject to budgetary availability.

- 3. Establish that the deadline for submitting applications, in accordance with the eighth base, is from 4 August to 30 October 2025, both inclusive.
- 4. The examining body is the head of the Management of the Institut Ramon Llull and the decision-making body is the head of the Management of the Institut Ramon Llull.
- 5. The members of the Evaluation Committee of this line of subsidy are appointed by resolution of the head of the Management of the Institut Ramon Llull, which is published on the notice board of the Electronic Office of the Institut Ramon Llull.
- 6. The proposal for a provisional decision to award the subsidies, the decision on the inadmissibility or withdrawal of the applications and the final resolution of the call are notified to the interested parties by publishing them on the notice board of the electronic headquarters of the Institut Ramon Llull and on the notice board of the Barcelona headquarters (Avinguda Diagonal, 373, 08008 Barcelona). This publication replaces the individual notification and has the same effects.

The publication of the resolution must state that it does not put an end to the administrative process and that an appeal may be lodged with the head of the Management of the Institut Ramon Llull against the resolutions of inadmissibility or withdrawal of the applications and an appeal against the head of the Presidency of the Board of Directors of the Institut Ramon Llull against the final resolution of the call.

If the maximum period of six months has elapsed without the final resolution of the call having been issued and published, applicants may consider their applications rejected due to administrative silence.

## **Appropriate appeals**

In accordance with Articles 121 and 122 of Law 39/2015, of 1 October, on the Common Administrative Procedure of Public Administrations, an appeal may be lodged against this resolution, which does not put an end to the administrative procedure, within one month of the day following the date of publication of this resolution in the Official Journal of the Government of Catalonia.
