

**RESOLUTION opening the third call 2023 to award grants, on a competitive basis, to translate original Catalan or Occitan (in its Aranese variant) literature and scholarly works**

**L0127 U10 3aC/2023**

1. Consortium Institut Ramon Llull (hereinafter Institut Ramon Llull) aims to project and disseminate Catalan language and culture, in all of its expressions, abroad. In pursuit of these aims, Institut Ramon Llull supports the foreign affairs policies of consortium institutions in the cultural arena.
2. By agreements of the Board of Directors dated 15 December 2022, approving modifications to the guidelines governing the awarding of grants to translate original Catalan or Occitan (in its Aranese variant) literature and scholarly works.
3. By resolution dated 9 January 2023 (DOGC number 8832, of 13 January 2023) announcing the agreements of the Board of Directors dated 15 December 2022, modifying the guidelines governing the awarding of grants to translate original Catalan or Occitan (in its Aranese variant) literature and scholarly works.
4. By agreements of the Board of Directors dated 31 March 2023, approving modifications to the guidelines governing the awarding of grants to translate original Catalan or Occitan (in its Aranese variant) literature and scholarly works.
5. By resolution dated 4 April 2023 (DOGC number 8893, of 12 April 2023) announcing the agreements of the Board of Directors dated 31 March 2023, modifying the guidelines governing the awarding of grants to translate original Catalan or Occitan (in its Aranese variant) literature and scholarly works.
6. As per articles 87 sqq. of Royal Legislative Decree 3/2002, of 24 December, approving the revised text of Public Finance Act of Catalonia, and the basic provisions of Law 38/2003, of 17 November (General Subsidies Act) and Royal Decree 887/2006, of 21 July, approving the Regulation of said law.

With the powers granted me in article 13.2 e) of the Institut Ramon Llull bylaws,

**Now, therefore, be it resolved that:**

1. The third call 2023 to award grants, on a competitive basis, to translate original Catalan or Occitan (in its Aranese variant) literature and scholarly works be opened.

The grants established for this call be governed by the modified guidelines approved by the Board of Directors on 15 December 2022, published in DOGC number 8832, of 13 January 2023 and its modification approved by the Board of Directors on 31 March 2023, published in DOGC núm. 8832 of 12 April 2023 and the General Subsidies Act.

2. The maximum earmarked for the call be €108,000.00 from the Institut Ramon Llull budget for 2023, through the following line items, which are endowed with adequate and sufficient funds:

D/005/104/ 470.000174 LITERATURE - TRANSLATION - Private companies / L127 TRADUCCIO

€5,000.00

D/005/104/ 490.000174 LITERATURE - TRANSLATION - Foreign markets / L127 TRADUCCIO €103,000.00

The maximum funding earmarked may be increased based on the applications received and budgetary allowances.

3. The period to submit applications, as per section eight, be set at 3 July to 6 November 2023, inclusive.
4. The examining body be the individual serving as the head of the Institut Ramon Llull management and the decision-making body, the individual serving as Director of Institut Ramon Llull.
5. The members of the assessment committee for this grant line are appointed by resolution of the director of the Institut Ramon Llull and is published on the Institut Ramon Llull online noticeboard.
6. Applicants will be notified of any resolutions on rejection and withdrawal of applications, and the final resolution for the awarding of grants via the Institut Ramon Llull online noticeboard and the physical noticeboard at its headquarters in Barcelona (Avinguda Diagonal, 373, 08008 Barcelona). This publication is in lieu of individual notification and has the same effects.

The publication of the resolution must state that it does not exhaust the administrative channels and that resolutions on rejection and withdrawal of applications may be appealed to the Director of Institut Ramon Llull and a final appeal of the final resolution of the call may be lodged with the President of the Institut Ramon Llull Board of Directors.

If no final resolution has been handed down and notified within six months, applicants are to interpret this administrative silence as a rejection of their applications.

### **Lawful appeals**

This resolution, which does not exhaust the administrative channels, as per articles 121 and 122 of Law 39/2015, of 1 October, on Common Administrative Procedure of Public Administration, may be appealed and any such appeals must be lodged with the President of the Institut Ramon Llull Board of Directors within one month of the day following the publication of this resolution in the Diari Oficial de la Generalitat de Catalunya (Official Gazette of the Government of Catalonia). The one-month term ends on the same date the resolution was published.
