

RESOLUTION MODIFYING THE BUDGET ENDOWMENT FOR THE FIRST 2023 CALL TO AWARD GRANTS, ON A COMPETITIVE BASIS, TO TRANSLATE ORIGINAL CATALAN OR OCCITAN (IN ITS ARANESE VARIANT) LITERATURE AND SCHOLARLY WORKS.

RECITALS

1. The Consortium Institut Ramon Llull (hereinafter Institut Ramon Llull) aims to project and disseminate Catalan language and culture, in all of its expressions, abroad. In pursuit of these aims, Institut Ramon Llull supports the foreign affairs policies of consortium institutions in the cultural arena.

2. By agreements of the Board of Directors dated 15 December 2022, approving modifications to the guidelines governing the awarding of grants to translate original Catalan or Occitan (in its Aranese variant) literature and scholarly works.

3. By resolution dated 9 January 2023 (DOGC number 8832, of 13 January 2023) announcing the agreements of the Board of Directors dated 15 December 2022, modifying the guidelines governing the awarding of grants to translate original Catalan or Occitan (in its Aranese variant) literature and scholarly works.

4. Resolution dated 18 January 2023 opened the first 2023 call for grant applications, on a competitive basis, to translate original Catalan or Occitan (in its Aranese variant) literature and scholarly works (DOGC number 8840 of 25 January 2023) (ref. BDNS 671386).

5. Point two of this resolution set the maximum earmarked for this call at €120,000.00 through the Institut Ramon Llull 2023 budget, in accordance with the following line items which are endowed with adequate and sufficient funds:

Point two also established that the maximum funding earmarked could be increased based on the applications received and budgetary allowances.

6. On May 9, 2023, the coordinator of the Literature and Thought Area of the Ramon Llull Institute issues a report in which she sets out the need to increase the budget allocated for this call, given the number of applications submitted.

The coordinator of the Literature and Thought Area of the Ramon Llull Institute proposes to increase the endowment of this call by THIRTY TWO THOUSAND EUROS (€32,000.00), through the modification of the initially planned budget items and the allocation of a new budget item as detailed below:

7. With the powers granted me regarding the awarding of grants in article 13.2 e) of the Institut Ramon Llull bylaws,

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED THAT:

The budget endowment for the first 2023 call to award grants, on a competitive basis, to translate original Catalan or Occitan (in its Aranese variant) literature and scholarly works be set at ONE HUNDRED AND FIFTY TWO THOUSAND EUROS (€152,000.00), from the Institut Ramon Llull 2023 budget, in accordance with the following line items which are endowed with adequate and sufficient funds:
