

**RESOLUTION 18 May 2022 modifying the budget endowment for the first 2022 call to award grants, on a competitive basis, to publish illustrated works in foreign markets.**

**RECITALS**

1. The Consortium Institut Ramon Llull (hereinafter Institut Ramon Llull) aims to project and disseminate Catalan language and culture, in all of its expressions, abroad. In pursuit of these aims, Institut Ramon Llull supports the foreign affairs policies of consortium institutions in the cultural arena.
2. By agreements of the Board of Directors dated 19 January 2022, approving modifications to the guidelines governing the awarding of grants to publish illustrated works in foreign markets.
3. By resolution dated 1 February 2022 (DOGC number 8600, of 7 February 2022) announcing the agreements of the Board of Directors dated 19 January 2022, modifying the guidelines governing the awarding of grants to publish illustrated works in foreign markets.
4. Resolution dated 8 February 2022 opened the first 2022 call for grant applications, on a competitive basis, to publish illustrated works in foreign markets (DOGC number 8606 of 15 February 2022) (ref. BDNS 609810).
5. Point two of this resolution set the maximum earmarked for this call at €45,000.00 through the Institut Ramon Llull 2022 budget, in accordance with the following line item which is endowed with adequate and sufficient funds:

Point two also established that the maximum funding earmarked could be increased based on the applications received and budgetary allowances.

6. Given the volume of applications received and the large sums eligible for the grant in all of them, the director of the Literature and Humanities Department at Institut Ramon Llull issued a report on 4 May 2022 expressing the need to change the amount earmarked for this call modifying the budget line item amount initially planned by €45,000,00, and increasing it by adding a further €12,000.00 from budget line item D/005/104/ 490.000173 LITERATURE - TRANSLATION - Foreign markets of the Institut Ramon Llull 2022 budget, which is endowed with adequate and sufficient funds.

7. With the powers granted me regarding the awarding of grants in article 13.2 e) of the Institut Ramon Llull bylaws,

**BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED THAT:**

The budget endowment for the first 2022 call to award grants, on a competitive basis, to publish illustrated works in foreign markets be set at FIFTY-SEVEN THOUSAND EUROS (€57,000.00), from the Institut Ramon Llull 2022 budget, in accordance with the following line item which is endowed with adequate and sufficient funds:
